BIOGRAPHY:

Future Womb is the brainchild of multi-instrumentalist and multidisciplinary Calgary artist Mikaela Cochrane, and collaborators Jordan Moe (guitar), Michael De Souza (bass), and Andrew Ellergodt (drums). This project's eclectic sound will keep you guessing.

Having performed at Sled Island, Femme Wave, BIG Winter Classic and Frog Fest, Future Womb has become one of Alberta's bands to watch. Their debut full-length album *BABYGIRLGALACTIC* was released in April 2019 with Mikaela's brother and mentor, Taylor Cochrane (36?, Jason Famous & Le Fame, Fuck Boy), as producer. Since its release, *BABYGIRLGALACTIC* has been charting on campus radio stations across the country.

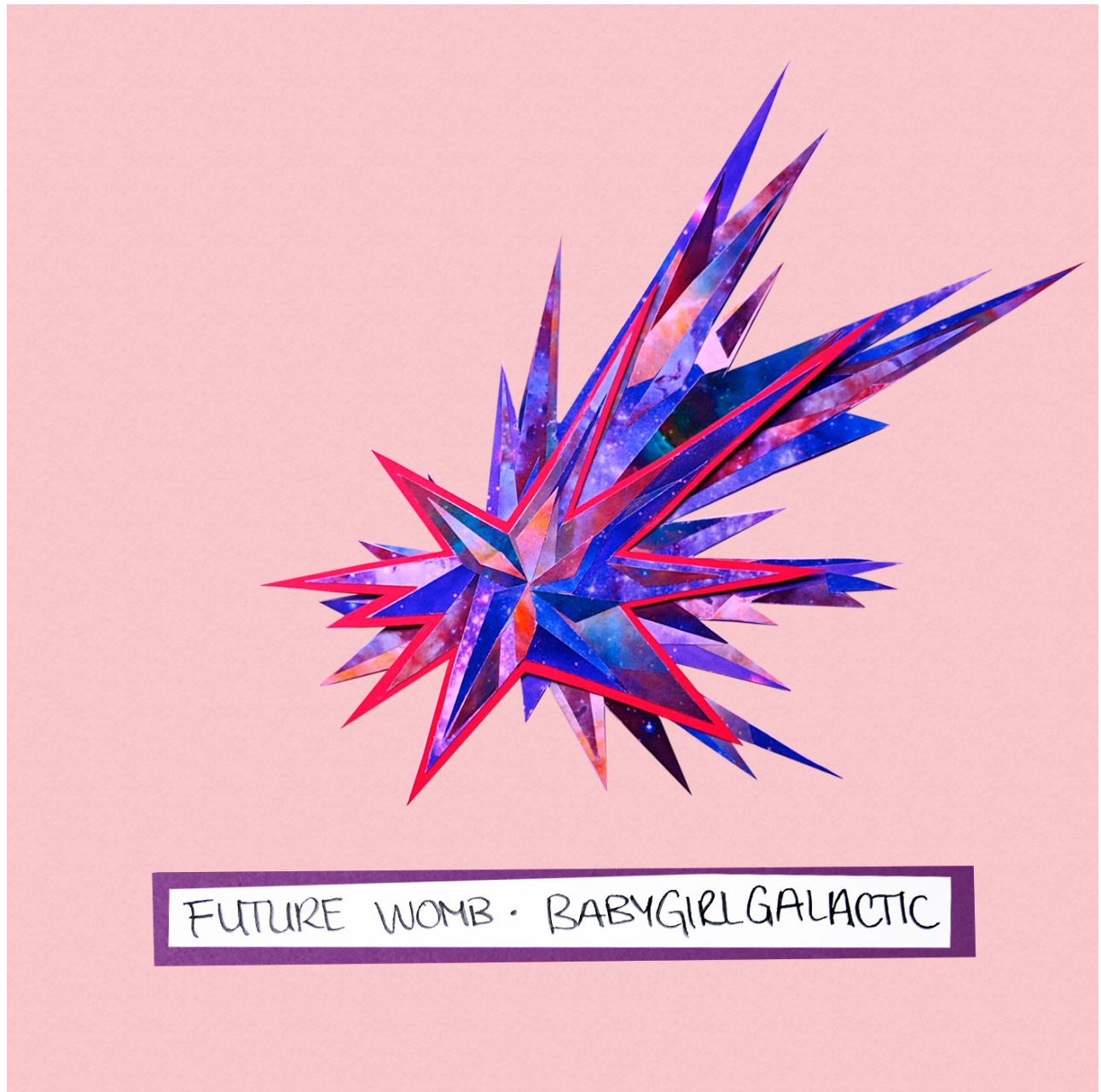

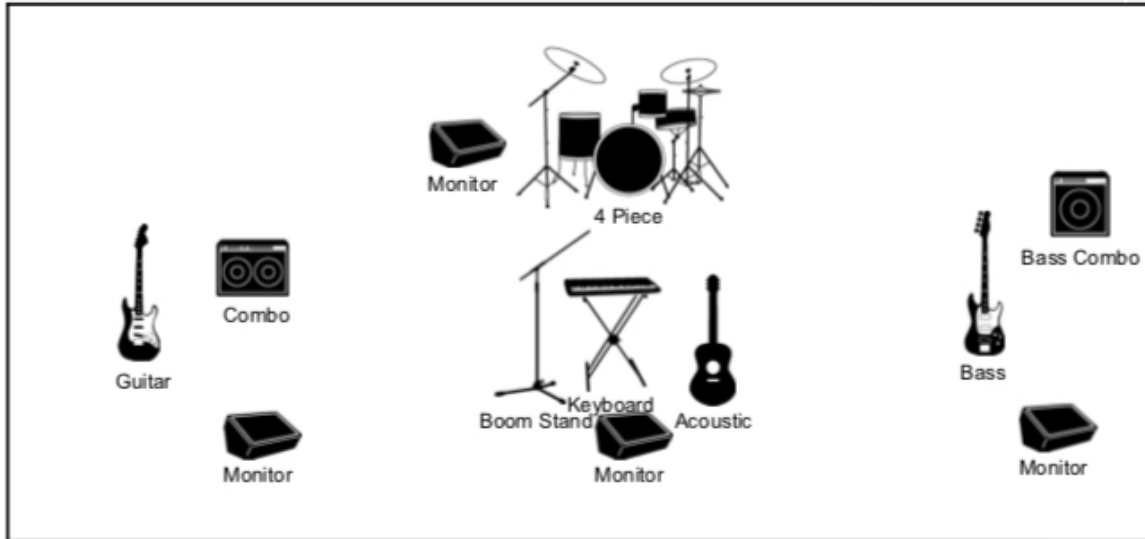
